ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

CAMP NURSING STAFF

Please help our nursing staff by filling out the **online medical form**. Please be diligent and list all allergies/medications in the appropriate section of the online form. All incomplete online forms will be charged a \$20.00 fee. If there is an area that doesn't apply, type n/a. All medications should be given to each church's group leader before leaving your church. Please have medications in their **original** bottle/box and inside a ziplock bag. Label **EACH** bag with child's name, church city, and church name.

MAIL/PHONE/VISITS

Breakaway is a weekend retreat, and there will be no mail deliveries. However, if a parent/guardian wishes to have the child(ren) receive a note or card to open at Breakaway, please have the parent/guardian write one prior to the event, collect them upon your departure, and given to the child(ren) at a time chosen by the chaperone. In order to provide a safe and positive environment, we discourage outside visitors. Visits and phone calls may encourage homesickness. If your child needs you, you will be contacted by the chaperone or Jeremiah Gruber, Camp Director.
